Dear Mr. Guzman

As promised, I hereby send you all the information about the protocol that will apply if you should come to Belgium.

Since the team and staff have trained together, they were all exposed to the players that tested positive and so all of them are high risk contacts.

If you should come to Belgium with this team, you shall therefore have to follow the Belgian rules for high risk contacts:

- 5 days of quarantine and a PCR test upon arrival: this means you cannot leave your hotel room during these 5 days and thus cannot train or play.
- A PCR-test will be taken after these 5 days:
 - If anyone tests positive (which is very likely), the whole team will have to stay in Belgium for at least 10 more days in quarantine and you will have to pay all costs yourselves.
 - If everyone tests negative, you will then be able to start the tournament.
